Background:	T.bryosalmonae is a causative agent of proliferative kidney disease (PKD), one of the most serious parasitic diseases of salmonid fish species in Europe and North America.
Host / Isotype:	Mouse / IgG1
Format:	State: Lyophilized purified Ig Reconstitution: 1.0ml PBS
Applications:	Immunohistochemistry on paraffin sections. Other applications not tested. Optimal dilutions are dependent on conditions and should be determined by the user.
Specificity:	This antibody recognises the extrasporogonic stage of the myxozoan parasite Tetracapsuloides bryosalmonae. The antibody is species specific and has been tested negative against several species of Sphaerospora, Myxidium, Myxobolus and Chloromyxum in a variety of fish species.
Storage:	Store the antibody in aliquots at -20°C for longer. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Shelf life: one year from despatch.
