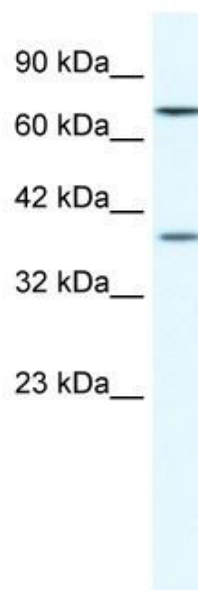

Format:	State: Liquid. Purified antibody supplied in 1x PBS buffer with 0.09% (w/v) sodium azide and 2% sucrose. Purification: Protein A affinity column
Applications:	Western blotting: 1.0 - 2.0 µg/ml. Immunohistochemistry on paraffin embedded tissues: 4.0-8.0 µg/ml. Other applications not tested. Optimal dilutions are dependent on conditions and should be determined by the user.

Species Reactivity:	Tested: Human, Mouse, Rat, Dog
Storage:	Store undiluted at 2-8°C for one month or (in aliquots) at -20°C to -80°C for longer. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Shelf life: one year from despatch.
