<u>Label:</u> Biotinamidocaproate N-Hydroxysuccinimide Ester (BAC)
<u>Protein Ratio:</u> 10-20 BAC molecules per Bovine IgG Fab molecule **Reconstitution:** Restore with 1.0 ml of deionized water (or equivalent).

Applications: Western Blot.

ELISA.

Immunohistochemistry. Immunofluorescence.

Other applications not tested. Optimal dilutions are dependent on conditions and

should be determined by the user.

**Description:** Biotin Conjugated Bovine IgG Fab fragment.

**Storage:** Prior to reconstitution store at 2-8°C.

Following reconstitution store the protein undiluted at 2-8°C for one month

or (in aliquots) at -20°C for longer. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Shelf life: one year from despatch.
