CHGB, also known as secretogranin-1 or chromogranin-B, is a neuroendocrine secretory granule protein, which may be the precursor for other biologically active peptides. This protein belongs to the chromogranin/secretogranin protein family and is expressed in the adrenal medulla, and in pheochromocytoma.

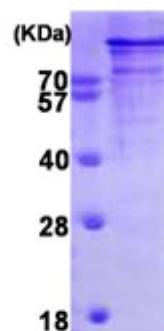
Storage:
