Background: Chlamydia is a common term for infection with any bacterium belonging to the phylum

Chlamydiae. This term derives from the name of the bacterial genus Chlamydiain the family Chlamydiaceae, order Chlamydiales, class and phylum Chlamydiae. There are two genera in Chlamydiaceae: Chlamydia and Chlamydophila. The genus Chlamydia includes three

species: C. trachomatis, C. muridarum, and C. suis.

Source: E. coli

Format: Purity: >95% pure as determined by 10% PAGE (coomassie staining) and RP-HPLC.

Purification Method: Chlamydia HSP70 protein was purified by proprietary

chromatographic technique.

Buffer System: 50mM Tris-HCl, pH 8.0, 8M Urea, 60mM NaCl and 50% Glycerol

Applications: Chlamydia HSP70 protein is suitable for use in ELISA.

Other applications not tested. Optimal dilutions are dependent on conditions and should

be determined by the user.

Description: The E.coli derived recombinant protein contains Chlamydia Trachomatis HSP70 protein

epitopes, 549-660 amino acids.

Specificity: Immunoreactive with sera of Chlamydia Trachomatis infected individuals.

Storage: Store undiluted at 2-8°C for one month or (in aliquots) at -20°C for longer.

Avoid repeated freezing and thawing. Shelf life: one year from despatch.
