The presence of specific IgG, in general, corresponds to maturation of the antibody response. It plays an important role in Antibody-dependent cell-mediated cytotoxicity (ADCC) and Intracellular antibody-mediated proteolysis, in which it binds to TRIM21 (the receptor with greatest affinity to IgG in

humans) in order to direct marked virions to the proteasome in the cytosol.
