Background:

PPP1R3B is the catalytic subunit of the serine/threonine phosphatase, protein phosphatase-1. The protein is expressed in liver and skeletal muscle tissue and may be involved in regulating glycogen synthesis in these tissues. This gene may be involved in type 2 diabetes and maturity-onset diabetes of the young. Alternate splicing results in multiple transcript variants that encode the same protein.
